Dear Parents & Guardians

ITH 2025 coming to an end, it is with heartfelt thanks that we bid farewell to Mrs Rachel Lee, who has led our school so ably as Principal for the past 7 years. As of 15 December, I have joined CHIJ Secondary as Principal and it is truly a homecoming

for me. I spent 10 years as a student in CHIJ Primary and Secondary where I had an excellent




