Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)

- Students who wish to apply for admission to junior colleges (JC), Millenia Institute (MI), polytechnics, and the Institute of Technical Education (ITE) may do so via the JAE using their GCE O-Level examination results.
- Eligible candidates will receive a digital copy of Form A via their registered email addresses from 2.45pm on Wed, 14 Jan 2026. Students should check their inbox, junk or spam folder.
- All candidates eligible for JAE may also download a copy of Form A from the JAE-Internet System (JAE-IS) during the application period.

Submitting Course Choices during JAE

- The JAE-IS will be accessible from 4pm on Wednesday, 14 January 2026, to 4.30pm on Monday, 19 January 2026.
- Applicants should submit their course choices through the JAE website at www.moe.gov.sg/jae using **Singpass**.
- To consider all 12 course choices wisely and fully utilise them. The choices should be listed in order of preference.

Submitting Course Choices during JAE

- Students can submit and amend their course choices via JAE-IS **until 4.30pm** on the last day of JAE application period.
- Upon successful submission, the verification slip will be sent to the email address provided by the student in the JAE-IS. If you do not receive the verification slip email, you should login to JAE-IS to check on your application status.

Submitting Course Choices during JAE

For Students who applied for DSA-JC / Poly EAE:

- Students who have accepted their DSA and EAE offers and have met the eligibility criteria / minimum entry requirements are **not** eligible to participate in JAE.
- Students who have accepted their offers but did not meet eligibility criteria / minimum entry requirements are eligible to apply for Polytechnic admission via JAE for courses which they are eligible for.


- **JCs and MI:** Students are to report to their posted institutions on **Wednesday, 4 February 2026** in your secondary school uniform.
 - If students are unable to report to their posted JC or MI on the first day of school due to valid reasons, they should contact their posted school directly to confirm that they are taking up the place.
- **Polytechnics:** Students will receive an email or package via mail on the enrolment details by **end-February 2026**.
- **ITE:** Students will receive an email on the enrolment details on **Tuesday, 3 February 2026**.

 - If you have applied for DSA-JC, you are eligible for admission to your chosen JC if your gross aggregate score is 20 points or less. You will not be eligible to apply for JAE.
- **MI:** L1R4 gross aggregate score of 20 points or better
(excluding bonus points)



4E5N: Polytechnics

You will need to meet **both** of the following requirements:

- Net ELR2B2 score of **26 points or better** (The exception is the Diploma in Nursing, whereby your ELR2B2-C net aggregate score must not exceed 28.)
- Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs) for the respective polytechnic courses
 - If you have applied for Polytechnic EAE, you are eligible for admission to your chosen course if meet both requirements above. You will not be eligible to apply for JAE.

4E5N: Progression to ITE

- **4E5N:** To refer to cut-off points and minimum entry requirements on the ITE website
 - Students who accepted conditional offers to an ITE course through the ITE EAE in 2025 and have their offers confirmed based on their GCE O-Level examination results will not be eligible to participate in the JAE.
 - Your EAE offers are confirmed if they meet the subject-specific Minimum Entry Requirements for the course.



4N[A]: Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

- The PFP is an alternative to the Secondary 5 N(A) year. It is a one-year foundation programme at the polytechnics that offers a practice-oriented approach to prepare students for entry into the relevant diploma courses.
- Students are eligible to apply for the PFP if they obtain a raw ELMAB3 aggregate of 12 points or lower, and meet the subject-specific requirements for their chosen course.

4N[A]: Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

- Admissions are restructured to a cluster-based approach from AY2026.
- Students will enter one of the following three key broad clusters. At the end of the PFP year, students will then apply to a specific diploma course, and posting will be based on their PFP performance and course choice:
 - Sciences
 - Design, Engineering & Technology
 - Humanities, Art, Media and Business
- Students seeking admission to Nursing, Tamil Studies in Early Education and Early Childhood Development & Education courses will continue to be admitted via the broad clusters or directly to these specific diplomas in.

4N[A]: Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

- PFP-eligible students will receive a copy of Form P. Each copy of Form P contains a unique password. Interested students should use the respective passwords to submit their applications online via the PFP website at <https://pfp.polytechnic.edu.sg/PFP/index.html>.
- Applications for the PFP will be open from **1.30pm** on **Wednesday, 14 January 2026**, to **4.30pm** on **Monday, 19 January 2026**.



4N[A]: Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

- The **PFP posting results** will be released at 1.30pm on Monday, 26 January 2026 through the PFP website. Students will be required to indicate whether they wish to accept, reject, or appeal for a change of course by 4.30pm on 29 January 2026.
- Please note that eligibility to apply for PFP does not guarantee admission, which is subject to availability of vacancies and based on merit.
- The last day of school for Sec 5 students who have accepted a place in the PFP will be on Friday, 30 January 2026. Students will be informed by the respective polytechnics on the enrolment dates for the PFP.

4N[A]: Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

- The DPP prepares students for progression into selected polytechnic diploma courses via a two-year Higher Nitec course at ITE.
- Students are eligible to apply if they obtain a raw ELMAB3 aggregate of 19 points or lower, and meet the subject specific requirements for their chosen course.
- Eligible Secondary 4 N(A) students may submit their DPP applications online via the DPP application portal at www.ite.edu.sg/apply-for-ite-courses.

Additional Information – DPP and PFP

- Students who have accepted a place in DPP Phase 1 and 2 in December but decide to take up a PFP offer now must withdraw from the DPP first before they are able to take up the PFP offer.
- DPP-enrolled students should check with their ITE class advisor for more details on the DPP withdrawal process and deadlines for withdrawal.

General advice on JAE

- Use all your 12 JAE choices carefully.
- Consider courses that align with your strengths and interests (e.g. engineering, healthcare or design courses).
 - List down all the institutions that offer courses that are aligned to your strengths and interests
 - For example, if you are interested in media, you could list down the media courses offered by the polytechnics and ITE, such as
 - Diploma in Film, Sound & Video (NP)
 - Diploma in Sonic Arts (RP)
 - *Higher Nitec* in Film and Video Production (2-year)(ITE)
 - *Higher Nitec* in Technical Theatre & Production (2-year)(ITE)


